**As an alternative to regular offering envelopes**, this is a perfect time to join our PAR (Pre-Authorized Remittance) program. In doing so you don't have to worry about picking up your envelopes or mailing/dropping off cheques. This helps to limit travels during Covid19 lockdowns and furthering reduction for any risk/contact. Here is the information you need to know about the PAR program.

**Under this arrangement, a monthly debit is made to your account on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month and credited the same day to TPC's account. You still have control over where you want your funds to be allocated. Eg., local, Presbyterian Sharing, PWS&D, etc. You can make changes, (increasing, decreasing, or cancelling) your pre-authorized amount at any time.**
