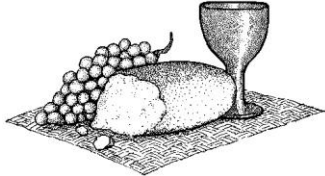
To continue to support the church through your regular offerings during this pandemic there are several options available to do so.
